

# PAIA Manual – Flag Finder (Pty) Ltd

Manual in terms of section 51 of the Promotion of Access to Information Act 2 of 2000 ("PAIA"), read with the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 ("POPIA")

## 1. Introduction

Flag Finder (Pty) Ltd ("**Flag Finder**", "the **Company**") is a private company registered in South Africa. It owns and operates **StrideNotes** ([stridenotes.co.za](https://stridenotes.co.za)), a practice management web application for SAVC-registered veterinary physiotherapists.

This manual is published in terms of section 51 of PAIA. It explains what records the Company holds, and the procedure for requesting access to those records. It also includes the processing information required by regulation, in terms of POPIA.

### 3. The Guide in terms of section 10 of PAIA

The Information Regulator has published a Guide, in all official languages, on how to use PAIA. It contains information a requester may need to exercise their rights, including the objects of PAIA and POPIA, contact details of all Information Officers, the manner and form of requests, and available remedies.

- Consumer Protection Act 68 of 2008

### 5. Records automatically available

- this PAIA manual; and
- marketing and product information.

### 6. Subjects and categories of records held

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<b>Subject</b>	<b>Categories of records</b>
<b>Company records</b>	Founding documents, statutory registers, minutes, share register
<b>Financial records</b>	Accounting records, financial statements, tax records, invoices, banking details
<b>Customer (User) records</b>	Account and registration details of StrideNotes users, subscription and billing records, support correspondence
<b>Client/practice data (held as operator)</b>	Client (pet owner) and patient (animal) records entered into StrideNotes by users – held on behalf of users, who are the responsible parties under POPIA
<b>Personnel records</b> (where applicable)	Employment contracts, remuneration records, contractor agreements
<b>Operational records</b>	Supplier and service-provider agreements, insurance, correspondence
<b>IT records</b>	System logs, access logs, backups

**Note:** records held by the Company as an **operator** on behalf of StrideNotes users are not the Company's records to disclose. Requests relating to a practitioner's client records should be directed to the relevant practitioner as responsible party.

## 7. Processing of personal information (POPIA – regulation-required disclosure)

### 7.1 Purpose of processing

Personal information is processed to: provide and administer the StrideNotes service; manage user accounts and subscriptions; process payments; deliver transactional email (including SOAP notes and veterinary reports sent on users' instructions); provide AI-assisted dictation and note generation; provide support; secure the service; and comply with legal obligations.

### 7.2 Categories of data subjects and personal information

<b>Data subjects</b>	<b>Personal information</b>
StrideNotes users (practitioners)	Name, contact details, SAVC registration number, account credentials, billing and payment records, usage data, content created in the app
Clients of practitioners (pet owners)	Name, contact details, address, correspondence, records linked to their animals (processed as operator on the practitioner's instructions)

Data subjects	Personal information
Employees/contractors (where applicable)	Employment and remuneration records
Suppliers	Contact and contract details

## 7.3 Recipients of personal information

Service providers processing on the Company's behalf: Hetzner (hosting, Germany), Supabase (database, EU-Frankfurt), Resend (email, USA), Anthropic and OpenAI (AI processing, USA), Paystack (payments). Also: regulators and authorities where required by law.

## 7.4 Planned transborder flows

Personal information is transferred to the European Union (hosting and database) and the United States (email delivery and AI processing) under contractual safeguards consistent with section 72 of POPIA.

## 7.5 Security measures

The Company implements appropriate, reasonable technical and organisational safeguards, including encryption in transit and at rest, access controls and role-based permissions, password hashing, logical data separation, backups, access logging, and contractual confidentiality obligations on all service providers and personnel.

# 8. How to request access to records

## 8.1 Procedure

1. Complete **Form 2** (Request for Access to Record), prescribed under the PAIA Regulations, 2021 – available from the Information Regulator's website (<https://inforegulator.org.za>) or from our Information Officer.
2. Submit the form to the Information Officer at [privacy@stridenotes.com](mailto:privacy@stridenotes.com).
3. Provide sufficient detail to identify the record, the form of access required, and proof of identity. If you act on behalf of another person, provide proof of capacity.
4. If the record contains third-party information, the Company may need to consult that third party before deciding.

## 8.2 Grounds

A requester must identify the right they seek to exercise or protect, and explain why the record is required for that purpose (section 50 of PAIA). **Data subjects requesting their own personal information** need not provide such grounds and pay no request fee.

## 8.3 Decision

The Company will decide on the request within **30 days** of receipt (extendable by up to 30 days in the circumstances permitted by PAIA) and notify the requester of the outcome using the prescribed form, including fees payable and, where access is refused, the reasons and available remedies.

## 8.4 Fees

Fees are prescribed by Annexure B of the PAIA Regulations, 2021 (verify current amounts at <https://inforegulator.org.za>):

- **Request fee:** R140 (not payable by a person requesting their own personal information);
- **Access/reproduction fees:** per the prescribed tariff (e.g. per-page photocopy/printing fees, electronic copies);
- a deposit may be requested where preparation requires more than the prescribed hours.

## 8.5 Remedies

The Company is a private body; there is no internal appeal procedure. A requester dissatisfied with a decision may:

- lodge a complaint with the **Information Regulator** (details below); or
- apply to a court with appropriate jurisdiction.

## 9. Grounds for refusal

Access may be refused on the grounds set out in Chapter 4 of Part 3 of PAIA, including protection of the privacy of third parties, commercial information of the Company or third parties, confidential information, safety of individuals, legal privilege, and research information. Mandatory disclosure in the public interest (section 70) applies where relevant.
